



Antalya Enerji Üretim A.Ş.

Brief History

Antalya Enerji was established on 27 December 2004 on a 20-decare land within the Antalya Organised Industrial Zone for the purpose of generating power and supplying steam to the industrialists located in the Zone.

The plant started commercial operations in 3 phase;

- First phase started to operate in July 2006 with 4 motors (4 x 8,73 MWe), at a capacity of 34,9 MWe
- Plant capacity was increased to 52,4 MWe with the addition of two further motors (2 x 8,73 MWe) in August 2008
- The plant achieved a total installed capacity of 94,2 MWe , addition of further 6 motors (6 x 6,97 MWe) in July 2009, having total of 12 gas motors.

The periodic maintenance of the plant, including materials and maintenance services, during its generation operations was performed by the supplier Wartsila/Enpa.

The plant's physical generation operations were stopped in June 2016, after which date no generation operations were carried out. The plant's generation licence was expired on 31.12.2016.

The protective maintenance of the plant was performed by the company Martek Service in April 2017, following the stoppage date of the plant's physical generation operations, while the monthly and weekly checks according to the **Protective Maintenance Procedures** continue to be performed by the technical personnel of Enda Holding.
